ADDENDUM 2

Clarifications and Modifications to the RFP

Answers to bidder questions:

Q1. Please advise the daily and annual service schedule for the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle?

Answer: Please see attached "Renegade Express Shuttle Routes"

Q2. Who is the current provider of the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle?

Answer: Bakersfield College currently does not have a shuttle service. Previously, it was Executive Express Lines, when classes were in session.

Q3. How long has the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle been operating in its current configuration?

Answer: Starting in September 2018.

Q4. What is the average, maximum and minimum passenger count on the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle?

Answer: 30-60 people per day.

Q5. How is the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle passenger count trending?

Answer: We do not have the statistics at this time.

Q6. The current BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle schedule appears to be too tight to operate with a single vehicle. Are you currently operating the service with two vehicles?

Answer: Two vehicles that start at separate locations.

Q7. What size is the current BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle? Is this sufficient for the service or would you like proposals for larger shuttles?

Answer: 20 passenger bus with ADA wheelchair. This is sufficient currently.

Q8. Does the BC to BC SouthWest Shuttle have any current unmet needs? What are your future objectives for the service?

Answer: Ability to have advertising within the shuttles, marking the exterior of the shuttles with a BC decal. Future objectives for service include outreach to the Delano campus center and the Job Spot on Panama & H Street and in two years to Arvin High School campus location.

Q9. Are there any other current or planned shuttle services anticipated by your RFP (such as Student Parking Shuttle service)?

Answer: Potentially, have not decided as of yet.

Q10. Your RFP specifies ADA charter coaches. Will you accept non-ADA coaches for charters that do not have a specific ADA requirement? Can you provide 48 hours' notice of charter ADA requirements?

Answer: No, all coaches need to have ADA compliance when requested. We can provide a 36-hour notice.

Q11. Please provide information regarding the number of annual and monthly charter service needs --- by campus, group size and time/distance (local 5 hrs. or less, local 6 to 10 driving hrs., long distance/overnight).

Answer: We do not have the statistics at this time. Currently, we utilize various means of transportation and many different transportation service companies. There is a need for daily shuttle service, various out of town Athletic events, i.e. overnight, 2 day for 20 hours/day from BC to Sacramento, etc.

Q12. For smaller than motorcoach sizes and local service, are basic shuttle vehicles acceptable (non-reclining seats, no restroom, etc.)?

Answer: Yes.

Q13. Do you have any specific vehicle amenities needs, such as seatbelts, power outlets, Wi-Fi, etc.?

Answer: ability to place advertising, incentives and more amenities. Power outlets would be nice, but not required.

All other specifications remain unchanged.
