

**PETITION FOR ADDING NON-TRADITIONAL COLLEGE CREDIT
TO PORTERVILLE COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT**

Non-traditional college may be added to the Porterville College transcript upon petition by the student. In all forms of non-traditional credit, the student must be currently enrolled at Porterville College and must have completed 12.0 units of work at Porterville College.

Note: Advanced Placement Exams that satisfy UC and CSU requirements should be checked for currency and specific college credit.

Non-traditional college credit, which a student may request to be added to the Porterville College transcript, are:

- 1. Advance Placement (General Examination)** – Porterville College participates in the Advanced Placement program offered by the College Entrance Examination Board. Credit is granted for the Advanced Placement Examination completed with scores of 3, 4, and 5. Students will receive unit credit but not letter grades for these courses. In order to receive credit, a student must have his/her official College Board test scores forwarded to Porterville College (hand carried copies will not be accepted).

It has been determined by the Porterville College Curriculum Committee on 10/10/2017 that we will accept and allow credit for the following Advanced Placement Examinations only:
